This program is designed to be completed in 30 Weeks (or 2 college terms).

This program will cost Virginia Residents \$17,671.77 if completed within normal time. (This figure includes average expenses for tuition, books, supplies, room and board, transportation, and personal expenses.) The tuition and fees portion of this total is \$4,225.50. Out of state student's estimated total cost is \$23,006.97. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

Of the students who completed this program within normal time, the typical graduate leaves with \$0 of debt. When there are fewer than 10 students completing the program within normal time, debt data is withheld to preserve confidentiality of the students. However, the debt for students attending Southside Virginia Community College averages \$0 due to the college's non participation in any type of loan program.
